A nominee **must** be a certified ISST member and have indicated their willingness to run for the position. All full and honorary members are eligible to nominate candidates and certified members may also nominate themselves. **All nominations must be supported by two other full members.** If you wish to nominate someone else, please first be sure your nominee is certified, and is willing and able to accept nomination for a board position.

All nominations must be made using the form available below and must be supported by two full members of the ISST. Please ensure that you complete all the information required.

All submitted nominations will be reviewed by the Election Committee and checked and verified in a confidential process. Information about verified nominations will be posted on an ongoing basis here:

We encourage you to participate in this very important process. You may send your nominations any time between now (October 7 2020) and October 31 2020 via email to kerrybps@btinternet.com.

Please use the nomination form and ensure that it is completely fully and correctly. Do not send your nomination to the LISTSERV. Do NOT use the LISTSERV as a means to promote your nominee(s) or your own candidacy. All nominees will have an opportunity to post their personal statement on the ISST website before the election takes place.

Voting in the Elections of the Executive Board is done electronically; [you can read about the rules and the procedure here](#).

On November 2020 you will receive log-in information by email to access the voting ballot on the website. You will have time to cast your vote up to and including November 22 2020.

2 Revised Timeline of Election Process

Nov 1	The Election committee will publish the final list of candidates on the ISST website
Nov 1-7	Personal statements of those standing for election will be available on the ISST website
Nov 8 - Nov 22	Voting period for the Executive Committee
Nov 26	Posting of Election results

Date(s)	Step
15 October	Announcing the election and naming the board members that will run again. ISST Board job descriptions to be provided
15 October	Call for nomination sent to membership; Job descriptions will be uploaded to website for membership to view
15-30 October	Nomination period. Nominations will be sent directly to the Election Committee, who will verify eligibility and interest of the nominated members.
30 October	Nomination period closes.
31 October	The Election Committee sends out a list in alphabetic order of the candidates to all members and calls for the election. The voting process will be described in detail in this communication.
31 October – 9 November	Candidates submit statements for view on the ISST website.
9 November -29 November	Voting Period
5 December	Announcement of successful candidates after they confirm their willingness to serve – winning candidates have three days to consider if they will accept the position.
10 December	Run-off elections if needed
